Creation Care Programme

What is the Creation Care Programme?

It is a training programme designed to equip and encourage lay ministry in the local church. This programme will resource and inspire

you to lead your church on a journey towards greater care and concern for God's wonderful Creation.

Where and When is it happening?

The programme consists of an opening and closing session and six Tuesday evening sessions spread over the term. We ask participants to commit to be present at every session so that they and those they are learning with get the most out of the training.

This spring we plan to hold the opening session in person at St Paul's Bursledon, SO31 8DT, and the six creation care sessions will be online. Topic sessions consist of pre-session online materials to work through (this is a key part of the course but you will normally have two weeks to complete it) followed by online Zoom sessions with a tutor.

- Launch Day Saturday 15 January 10.00 am—3.00 pm.
- Creation Care sessions Tuesday evenings 7.00—8.30 pm. On 18th Jan, 1st & 15th Feb, 8th 15th & 29th Mar
- Closing Session Saturday 2 April 9.30am—12 noon.
