2.5 Service incorporating the O Antiphons

(see fabulous banners used at Salisbury Cathedral Advent service)

For those not familiar with the O Antiphons – They are familiar to us in the hymn O come, O come Emmanuel. Each verse parallels one of the antiphons.

Wisdom, Ruler of the house of Israel, Root of Jesse, Key of David, Rising Dawn, King of the Gentiles, and Emmanuel.

...a magnificent command of the Bible's wealth of motifs.

Actually a collage of Old Testament types of Christ.

Jesus is invoked by various titles, mainly taken from the prophet Isaiah.

The sequence progresses historically, from the beginning, before creation, to the very gates of Bethlehem.
