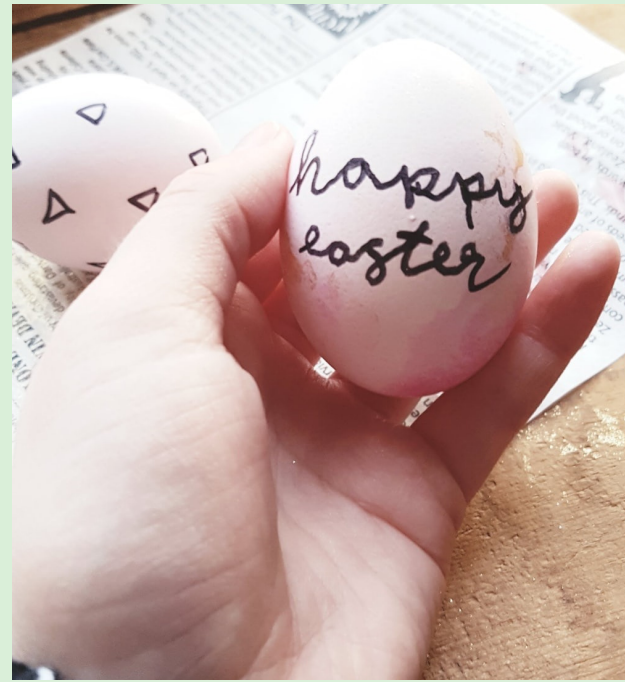

Beyond the grounds...

Bunny Hop

Easter egg hunt with a twist. Several stops around the neighbourhood where children are to collect pieces of the story. By the end of the hunt they will have a complete story plus chocolate!

Easter Garden

An invitation to make an Easter garden at home and bring into church building to be displayed.

Bake Along

Live baking video creating 'Easter nests' can include readings and a song.

On the grounds...

Decorate a chosen object which is to be placed in the church grounds eg. Eggs, stones, ribbons.

Prayer wall

Offer a place of reflected prayer, people can add prayer cards to create a wall where people can sit/walk by and read.
