

God's people will shine like the sun in their Father's kingdom *Matthew 13:43*




All but one of these 13 words are in the grid.
Can you spot the one that's


Can you spot the one that's NOT there?

corn and weeds grow together until harvest


then keep good but burn bad

Which one of the flowers is not in the picture?







A word search for you to solve - all the words are hidden somewhere!
