## How to apply for permission for children to receive communion before confirmation in your parish

- 1. Contact the Adviser for Work with Children and Families, Barbara Meardon, in the first instance. She will be available for support and advice through the whole process. <u>Click here</u> to email her.
- 2. Enable a substantial discussion at PCC, perhaps using an outside speaker.
- 3. Allow plenty of time for discussion, reflection and prayer, involving children's leaders and the whole congregation.
- 4. Move to a PCC decision.
- 5. Prepare a teaching programme for children and their parents, as well as a programme of continuing learning for the children after admission including a planned approach to confirmation.
- 6. Consider the implications for your pattern of services, the liturgy, the participation of all ages and your baptism policy and preparation.
- 7. Communicate with the Diocesan Adviser and, once she has agreed that you have gone through steps 1-6, write to the Bishop asking for permission to admit children to Holy Communion before Confirmation.
- 8. Plan a date on which to admit the children, and deliver your preparation sessions.
- 9. Plan the service at which admission will take place for the first time.
- 10. Record the children's names in a register.
- 11. Give each child a certificate as an official record (available here).
