A Safeguarding concern is reported, or identified, by someone within the parish or anonymously Is the Child/Adult at Immediate Risk? NO Concern about a member Concern about a member If the person is at immediate risk of of the clergy or church officer of the congregation physical harm or needs medical attention, dial 999 to contact the Ambulance Service and/or the Police, and follow the advice **Contact the Diocesan Safeguarding** given. Inform Parish Clergy, and the Adviser Heather Bland or Jem Carter **Parish Safeguarding Officer:** Contact details on front page of the safeguarding area of the diocesan As soon as possible (but within 24hrs) website. follow the reporting and recording process in green on the right. They will be able to advise on the next steps. Formally report to the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser Heather **Parish Contacts:** Bland or Jem Carter Record the concern (who, what, when, where, why, how?) within 24hrs of an issue having been raised, and file it securely in the parish office. Send a copy to the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser.
