Volunteer Church Youth Group Helper

The church youth club is primarily aimed at those aged 11-14 who are part of the church community to come together and join in with a programme of activities that provide opportunities for them to explore the Christian faith, grow in discipleship and have fun. The group meets in the church hall every other Sunday from 7pm to 8:30pm

Main Aims of the Role

- 1. To provide young people within the 11–14 age range with an opportunity to meet together to explore and grow in the Christian faith in a way that is relevant to their lives
- 2. To enable the growth and development of young people so that they are more able to take responsibility for themselves, recognise the needs of others, and grow in discipleship.
- 3. To encourage young people to be involved in the wider life of the church

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. To help to implement a programme of faith related and fun activities.
- 2. To attend planning and team meetings on a half termly basis.
- 3. To arrive at the church hall at 6:30pm to help prepare the room, and stay until 09pm in order to return it to its normal state.
- 4. To work together with a team of other volunteers.

SUPERVISION AND SUPPORT

- 1. The youth club leader will provide half termly supervision.
- 2. Training requirements will be discussed with the youth club leader and access given to appropriate courses, the cost of which will be met in full by the church.
- Any mileage and out-of-pocket expenses will be met in full by the church and should be submitted to the treasurer by the end of the month.

SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE

- 1. A commitment to the needs of young people and a desire to see them appropriately supported and resourced in order that they can grow and develop to their full potential is important.
- 2. A Christian faith
- 3. Previous experience of working with this age range is not essential.
