## Role

Members of the Healing Ministry Prayer Group pray in twos with people who seek prayer during the Sunday morning services and during other services where directed

## Requirements

In order to be a member of the Healing Ministry Prayer Group a person should:

- Have been selected by the Healing Ministry Prayer Group Team leader and with the agreement of the priest in charge.
- Have been recruited in line with \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*'s Recruitment Procedure
- Abide by the Salisbury Diocesan Guidelines for Good Practice in the Healing Ministry
- Attend bi-monthly Healing Ministry Prayer Group meetings in order to pray with other members of the team, share fellowship and discuss any particular issues which may have arisen.
- Be responsible for their personal learning and development by attending courses run by Salisbury Diocese or other organisations
- Observe confidentiality in respect of information that they hear in course of exercising their ministry, in line with the guidance in the Salisbury Diocesan Guidelines for Good Practice in the Healing Ministry
- Report any concerns about the abuse of a child or an adult who may be at risk of abuse to the Parish Safeguarding Representative or the priest in charge.

## **Requirement for a Disclosure and Barring Service Check**

The role of Healing Ministry Prayer Group Member will be subject to an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check because they may have significant and unsupervised contact with both children and vulnerable adults.
