Pentecost Pause Day 2019 Notes

We are learning to understand the Holy Spirit as a helper from God who helps Christians with their behaviour. We are learning that Jesus wants Christians to show God's love to others. We are learning to show love to people in a variety of practical ways.



9:00 Register and give out coloured name labels

9:05 Assembly to introduce the day and sort children into groups

9:20 Every group perform the reflective story of God's Big Rescue Plan (an overview of the 'Big Story' of the whole Bible).

Follow up with a couple of wondering questions:

- → "How do you think the disciples felt when Jesus went back to Heaven?"
- → "How do you think that Jesus' leaving present of the Holy Spirit helped his friends?"
- → "What do you think a Christian would say is the most important part of the story? Why?"

Jesus gave his disciples one Great Command, he said: "Love one another as I have loved you."

Look at some Bible verses about love (printed on cards) – why do you think there are so many verses about love in the Bible? What can we learn from them? How can they influence our attitudes, behaviour and actions?

The Holy Spirit helps Christians to keep this commandment by:

- → helping them to know + feel what is right and wrong,
- → helping them to love other people and show God's love to them.
