SDBE offers support to Trusts, Members, Directors, Trustees, CEOs and Trust Improvement Teams including an annual I hour conversation with the CEO.

A bespoke programme can be prepared to meet your needs as you consider how to develop Trust practice. This is at a significantly reduced rate in acknowledgement of the key role of Trust and SDBE partnership as system leaders in an ever-changing educational landscape.
