THEME: EYFS - CREATION

Week	Learning Intention	Questions/ Activities	T/I/C
1	To understand what it means to make or create something.	What do you like making? Children to have a selection of resources to make something, e.g. playdough, lego, paint.	
2	To know the Christians see God as a creator.	What do you know about God as a maker or creator? Read a simple revision of the Christian creation story – sequencing creation pictures – farm set/jungle set.	
3	To understand that Christians believe that God is the giver of life.	Re-cap some of the things God created. Ask children to create a new plant or animal. Is your animal or plant alive? Why not?	
4	To understand that Christians believe that God is the giver of life.	Focus on creation of sea creatures, story about fish e.g. 'Rainbow fish' or 'The Fish who Could Wish' – Creating jellyfish with different materials (see understanding Christianity ideas) songs e.g. 'If I were a Butterfly'.	
5	To know that Christians believe that God asked Humans to look after the world.	Link to eco/recycling, things we do to look after our planet. (move onto Harvest Festival songs, simple prayers to thank God for Creation) – could link to 'pets' topic.
