They put this crown of thorns on Jesus’ head. They put a stick in his right hand. Then the soldiers bowed before Jesus and made fun of him. They said, “Hail, King of the Jews!” <sup>30</sup> They spit on Jesus. Then they took his stick and hit him on the head many times. <sup>31</sup> After they finished making fun of Jesus, the soldiers took off the robe and put his own clothes on him again. Then they led Jesus away to be killed on a cross.</p>

I will give you rest.<sup>29</sup> Accept my work and learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will find rest for your souls. <sup>30</sup>The work that I ask you to accept is easy. The load I give you to carry is not heavy.”</p>
10	Jesus is stripped of his clothing	<i>John 19:23-24</i>	<a href="https://www.biblegateway.com/passage/?search=John+19%3A23-24&amp;version=ICB">https://www.biblegateway.com/passage/?search=John+19%3A23-24&amp;version=ICB</a>	<p><sup>23</sup> After the soldiers nailed Jesus to the cross, they took his clothes. They divided them into four parts. Each soldier got one part. They also took his long shirt. It was all one piece of cloth, woven from top to bottom. <sup>24</sup> So the soldiers said to each other, “We should not tear this into parts. We should throw lots to see who will get it.” This happened to give full meaning to the Scripture:</p> <p>“They divided my clothes among them.      And they threw lots for my clothing.” <i>Psalm 22:18</i></p> <p>So the soldiers did this.</p>

There the soldiers nailed Jesus to his cross. They also nailed the criminals to their crosses, one beside Jesus on the right and the other beside Jesus on the left. <sup>34</sup> Jesus said, “Father, forgive them. They don’t know what they are doing.”<sup>[a]</sup></p>

This means, "My God, my God, why have you left me alone?"

(Joseph was a secret follower of Jesus, because he was afraid of the Jews.) Pilate gave his permission. So Joseph came and took Jesus' body away.

So Pilate told Joseph he could have the body. <sup>46</sup> Joseph bought some linen cloth, took the body down from the cross and wrapped it in the linen. He put the body in a tomb that was cut in a wall of rock. Then he closed the tomb by rolling a very large stone to cover the entrance. <sup>47</sup> And Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joseph saw the place where Jesus was laid.
