Andy has worked as a teacher, senior leader, head teacher and NLE. He became Director of the NCSL in 2009 leading on the London Challenge Programme. He was subsequently responsible for setting up the government's TS programme, before being appointed as Managing Director of one of the country's largest academy groups. In 2014 Andy founded Leadership Matters, an organisation that aims to improve educational outcomes for pupils by working alongside educational leads at all levels.
