1) What is the 'Personality and Character' of your Church?

- * Rural in outlook celebrate Rogation Sunday.
- * Older age profile, traditional beliefs.
- * Have embraced modest change; inc. one lay-led service / month.
- * Mainly middle class, relatively better-off, live in the village.
- * Lack of children in services.

2) What are the priorities of your local church?

- * Seeking greater involvement of a wider number of people.
- * Attempting to draw in a younger generation, being more inclusive.

3) In there one thing you'd like to take on in the coming year?

* Publicity - consider ways of more effectively promoting the church.

4) Are there ways in which we can work together to achieve more?

- * For the Diocese to keep their web site up-to-date and improve links.
- * For the Diocese to share good practice from other organisations/parishes on the web site i.e. Rogation Service resources obtained from York Diocesan web site.
- * Surprise visit to the parish by the Bishop.

5) How can we best measure the quality and impact of church life?

- * The degree of community involvement but hard to measure.
- * Audit note individuals' activities both 'in the name of the Church' and purely as neighbours.
