Generous Giving

Our Diocesan Stewardship Campaign is now scheduled to start in September.

Clergy from around the Diocese attended a Zoom 'Archdeaconry Day' on 9th February as part of our preparations for the Diocesan Stewardship Campaign. It was a 2-hour webinar introducing the theme of the Campaign – Generous Giving – and some of the materials being prepared to help us. There were expert speakers from the wider church, input from our own clergy and a chance to ask the difficult questions.

At the end, more than half of those who attended said they felt their confidence in being able to address stewardship issues had been boosted. Comments included: "Good investment of 2 hours. Thank you. Seeds sown..." and "Big thank you to all contributors. Excellent session."

The main sessions were recorded, and the webinar will be repeated on 9th March at 10am.
