Lent, Holy Week and Easter

On Ash Wednesday (17th February) Bishop Nicholas will be presiding and preaching in our Cathedral at the 5.30pm Eucharist and Imposition of Ashes.

The service will be live streamed, [here](#).

The Bishop invites those who do not have their own services at this time to join him.

Writing to clergy last month, the Bishop said:

"If it is helpful, you might want to direct people to this service, not just to save additional local provision but as a way for the Diocese to gather together at the start of Lent."

He added:

"The Blessing of Oils and the Renewal of Ordination Vows on Maundy Thursday in the cathedral at 11.00am is a highlight in the diocesan year. It, too, will have to be live streamed but I hope you will make it a priority to be there online.

"It is wonderful preparation for the keeping of the Great Three Days throughout the Diocese.

"There is an upside to our enforced circumstances in that no one will have to travel and this year the clergy from the Channel Islands will join us for the first time."

Both services will also remain online for a limited period after their broadcast.
