The Diocesan Board of Education team is working with both Local Authorities on the wide ranging issues faced by schools.

As well as supporting the co-ordination of school places to transport and meals, this also includes the essential work involving safeguarding of and communication with vulnerable pupils and their families.

Whilst as a charity we have needed to furlough staff to avoid significant redundancy in the future, we are glad to hear that these staff have become immediately involved in a range of community volunteering.

In the meantime, the 4 remaining DBS*-checked advisers and the small administration team have taken on the responsibilities of others, enabling us to respond to the breadth of needs that schools and parishes are bringing to us.
