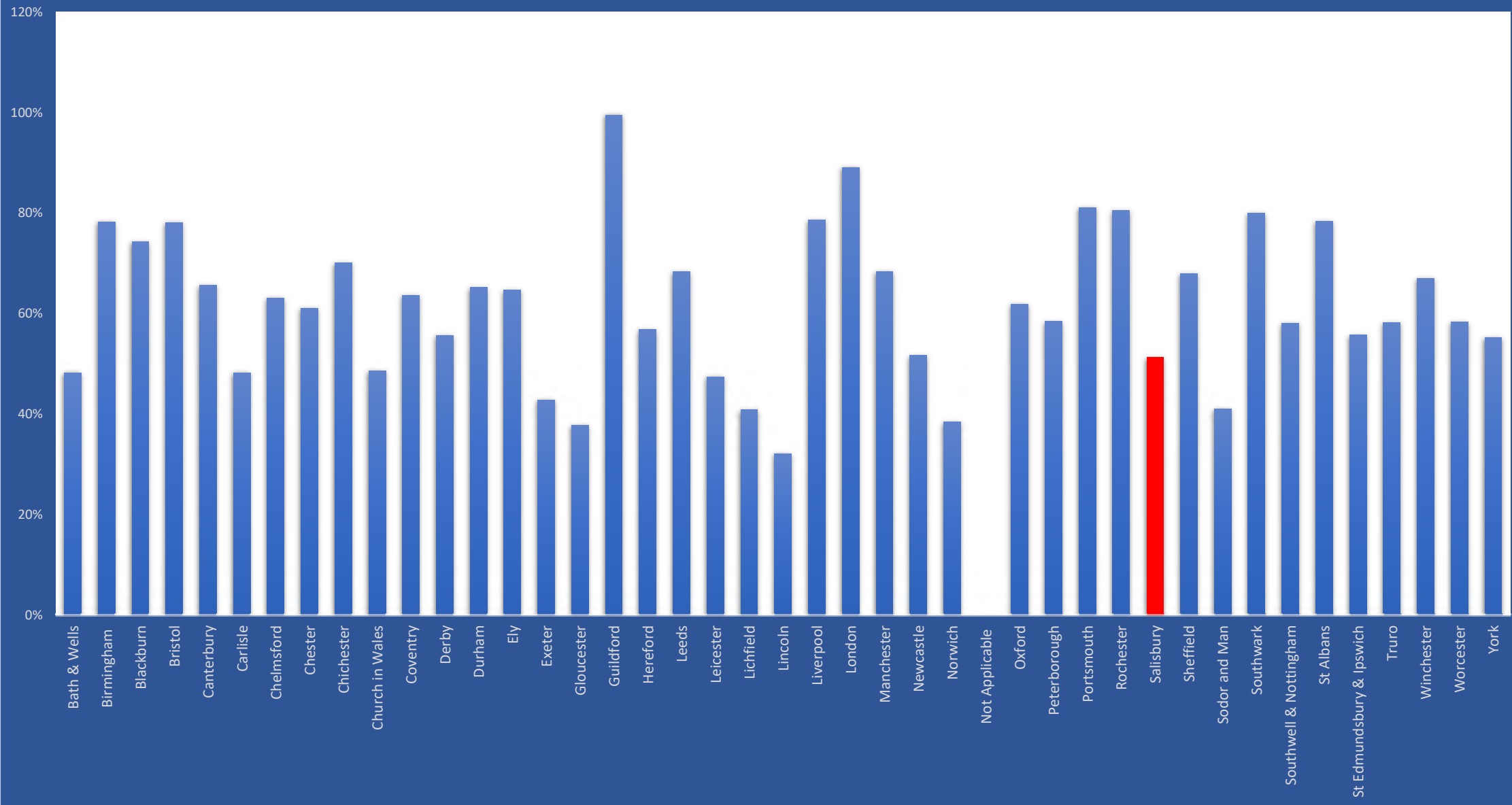


What is Parish Buying?



- Provided by the national church (Church of England Central Services)
- Access to nationally negotiated contracts for energy, and a range of other products and services * telecoms and internet * church software * office and catering * PPE and Covid Hygiene * photocopiers * fire safety * building maintenance * **Contactless** * **online giving** * LED lighting * energy audits ** **coming soon – audio-visual equipment** **
- Free of charge to join
- 10,500 church accounts
- Over 20,000 churchwardens, treasurers, administrators and clergy have registered
- Monthly newsletter
- Financed by listing fees and commission from suppliers

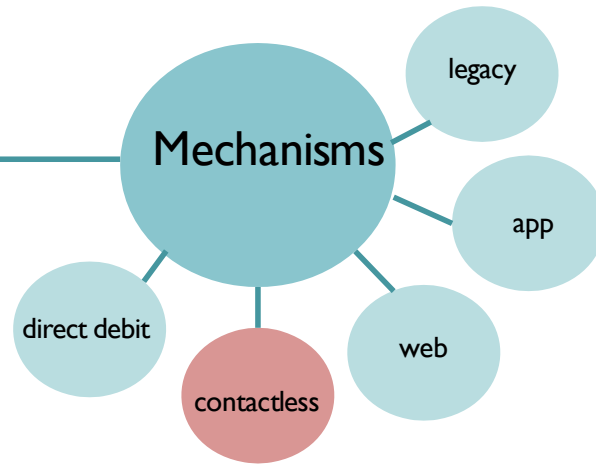

Giving Practice

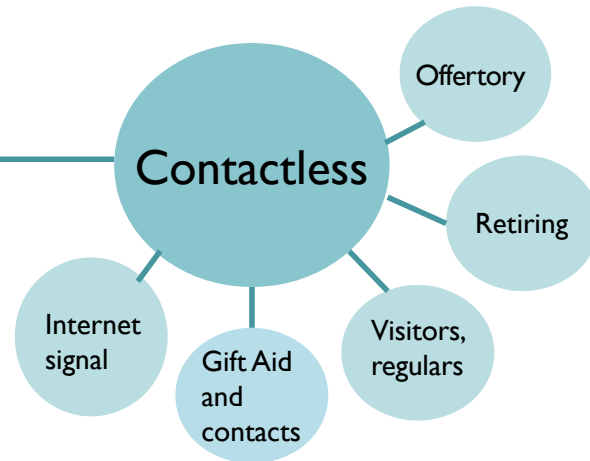


This is about the ways people give. The easier it is to give, the less 'friction' there is in giving, the more likely people are to give.

What are your objectives?

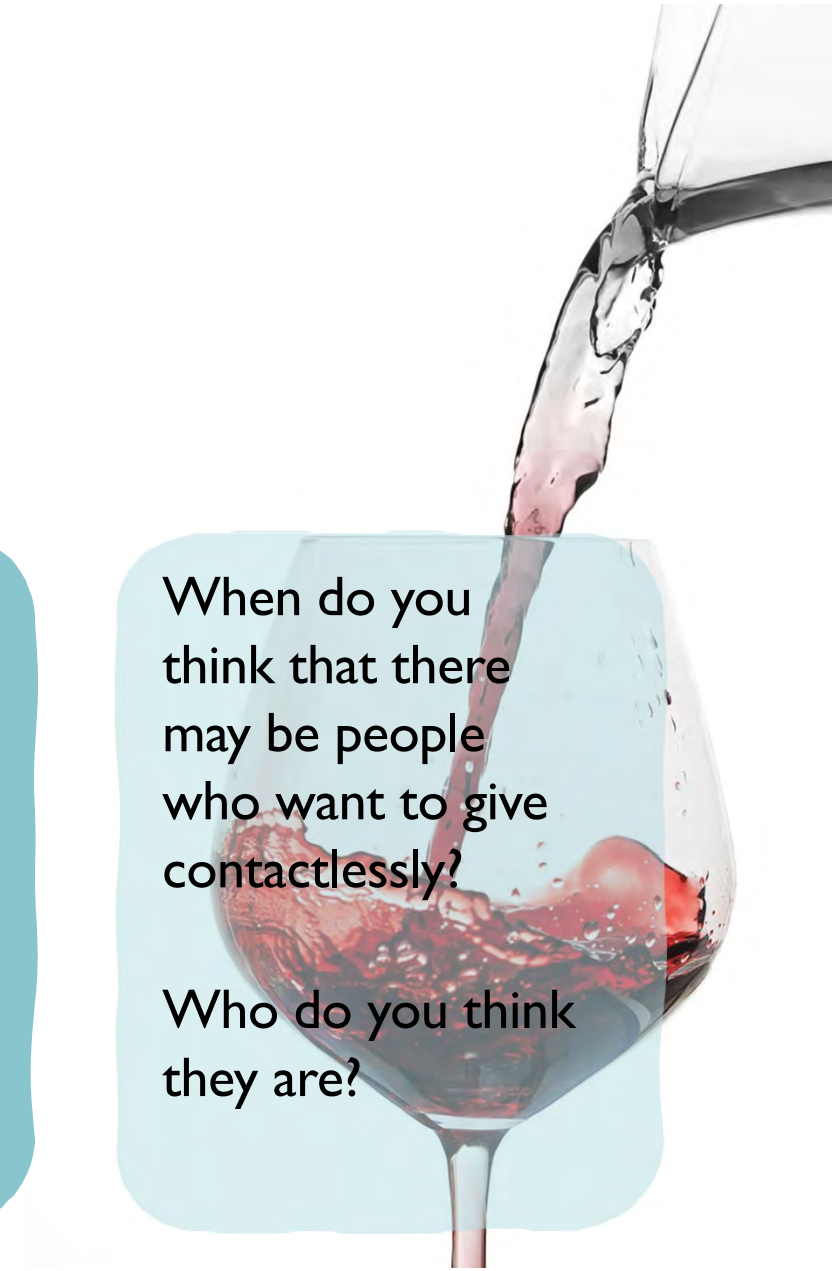
Some solutions are more technical than others – how can your church ensure that devices are running when needed?

Online Giving for your Church

Online giving enables people to give to your church through the Internet without having to visit your church building. It is simple to set up an online giving account, and once you have set up your account you will be able to link it to your church website or social media page, making it easy for people to give.

Why do I need online giving?

As our church buildings are not being visited or used as they normally are, being able to receive donations through online giving has never been more crucial. At Parish Buying we have developed an online giving service for churches.

Do you need connectivity

No, not all the time, but to upload the transactions

Chip+Pin

Yes, if you take the lid off

Gift Aid

Yes – GASDS, Paper Forms

Cost for transaction

2.25% + 10p per transaction

Monthly cost

£8 per month
