Inspiration for Churches

If you know any churches in need of inspiration for TKC 2021, throughout this week on social media, we'll be sharing 5 ways churches can be involved. This includes the <u>virtual 'Upper Room'</u> <u>resource</u> – inspired by the book of Acts, <u>Outdoor Pentecost Service outline</u>, prayer walking, hosting a Cheeky Pandas family service or using any one of the <u>range of digital resources</u> we have produced.

This year, we have produced a 3 x video series for children, youth and adults for TKC. Please see an update below on the relevant content:

For young children - Cheeky Pandas - update:

- For episode there will be an accompanying activity packs, family service sheets and catechist/ catholic versions. <u>See here.</u>
- This Sunday [25th April], we will be sharing the episode of CP with Bear Grylls, postponed due to HRH Duke of Edinburgh's death. It will air at 4.00pm BST on Thy Kingdom Come's YouTube and Facebook channels.
- Cheeky Pandas will feature in BBC Songs of Praise on Pentecost Sunday! Will send more of an update shortly.
- We are still running the Cheeky <u>Pandas Bake off competition</u> until 26th April for young amateur bakers and creatives. 5 runners ups to win prizes and will be judged by former Bake Off contestant Martha Collinson.
- The children's app will be available in the next 2 weeks.

For Young people - Youth reflections- update:

We have produced a series of <u>11 video reflections</u>, in partnership with the Archbishop of York's <u>Youth Trust</u>, from young influencers including Guvna B, Pippa Baker, Joshua Luke Smith, Elle Limebear and more for this year's Thy Kingdom Come. Each video is based on one of the daily themes of TKC and has an accompanying discussion plan suitable for use in schools, colleges, youth groups and at home.

A few people have enquired about the Escape Room and this will be available in the next 2 weeks – in time for Thy Kingdom Come.

For all (Adults) - 11 main videos - update:

Includes a range of voices from Archbishop Angaelos to Bishop Rose Hudson Wilkin, hidden heroes and front-line workers of the pandemic to the Methodist Youth president and climate activist, Phoebe Parkin.

These will be featured on the award-winning TKC app which will be available early May (also available in 8 different languages.)

These videos will also air on TBN UK and God TV UK in the coming months.

- Commitment to inclusion and accessibility Thy Kingdom Come are supremely committed to being accessible for all. Some of the steps taken include: teaming up with the Torch Trust to produce key resources in Braille & large print versions available too; The Cheeky Pandas and main 11 videos will be in BSL; we have Cheeky Pandas activity packs for children with learning disabilities and there are a number of other things in the pipeline. Please let us know if you have any requirements.
